## FLEXIBILITY

With the Rhine accessible 24/7 and regular rail links, high volumes of freight traffic can be handled at all times.

## ECO-FRIENDLY TRANSPORT

A barge transports the equivalent of up to 220 trucks. That means 220 fewer vehicles on the roads.

## RELIABILITY

River and rail transport are better suited to high-volume container traffic without the hazards of gridlocked roads. The major seaports encourage this form of transit to relieve congestion on the main road links.

## PORT OF THE FUTURE

The Port of Strasbourg has gone through a full-blown digital transition.

Together with our partners, we have developed new web tools to improve our multimodal services, ensure smoother traffic flows at our various sites and simplify container transport.

Carriers, freight forwarders and logistics specialists have access to:

### SERVICES DEVELOPED BY THE PORT

- VIGIE to declare your port fees online.
- Rhine Ports Information System, developed by the Upper Rhine ports, to book loading docks online (available soon).

### SERVICES DEVELOPED BY RET

- Fast Gate, allowing carriers and their truck drivers to carry out administrative registration formalities from a computer or smartphone before they reach the port.
- ETIS to identify stock levels and check progress on customer containers.

### SERVICES DEVELOPED BY VNF AND EDF

- E-RIS to calculate the estimated time of arrival of a vessel and anticipate docking in the Port of Strasbourg.

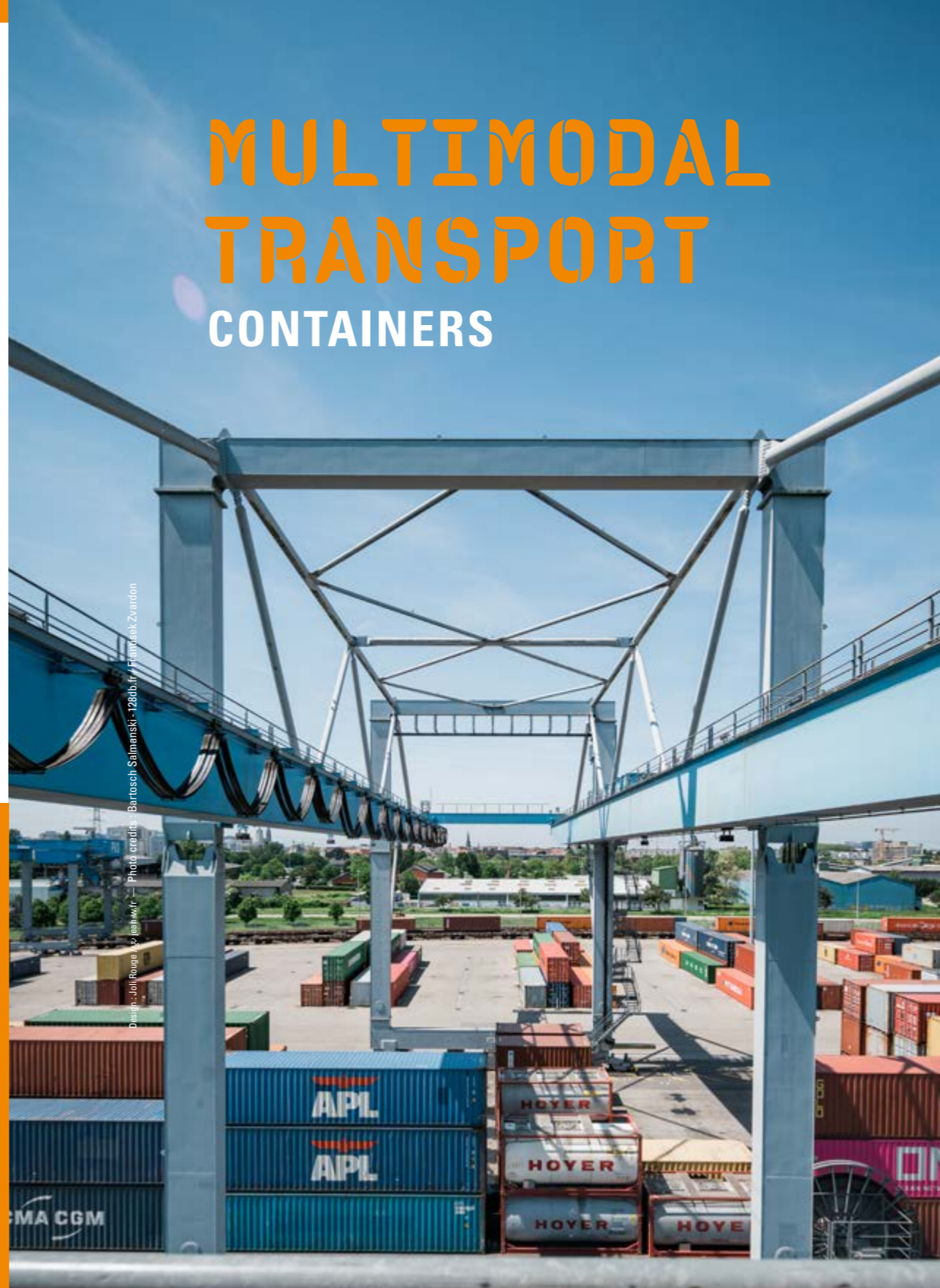

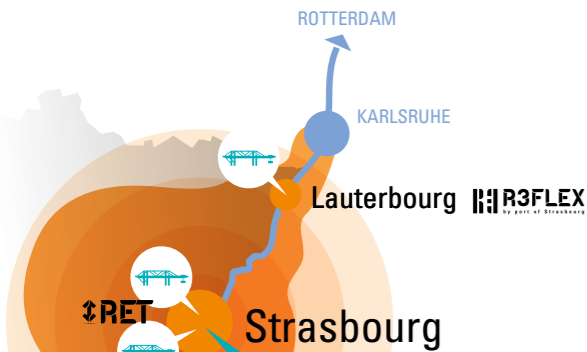

# THE TRIMODAL PORT OF STRASBOURG: THE 3 Rs

The Port of Strasbourg's container terminals boast excellent road and rail links. Carriers can rest assured that their containers will be routed safely and transhipped smoothly from one mode to another.



## RHINE

THE RHINE IS EUROPE'S PRIMARY RIVER TRADE ROUTE. All Port of Strasbourg sites are directly connected to the river. Our terminals have the infrastructures required to manage mode transfers efficiently for around 30 calls per week.

## ROAD

EACH PORT OF STRASBOURG TERMINAL enjoys easy access to the French and German motorway networks:

- THE RHINE VALLEY VIA THE A35
- PARIS VIA THE A4

## RAIL

THE PORT OF STRASBOURG OWNS 100 KM OF TRACK, directly connected to the national rail network. Daily shuttles run to and from the major maritime hubs.
